IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE HOLOCAUST EDUCATION (A) ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM. (B) **(1)** THERE IS A HOLOCAUST EDUCATION ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM IN THE STATE. THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO ASSIST LOCAL SCHOOL **(2)** SYSTEMS WITH HOLOCAUST EDUCATION IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

- 1 (C) A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM MAY APPLY TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR A 2 GRANT FROM THE PROGRAM.
- 3 (D) A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM MAY USE A GRANT ONLY FOR 4 HOLOCAUST-RELATED:
- 5 (1) TEACHER TRAINING; OR
- 6 (2) TEACHING MATERIALS.
- 7 (E) (1) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL 8 AN APPROPRIATION OF \$500,000 FOR THE PROGRAM.
- 9 (2) NO LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL RECEIVE MORE THAN \$50,000 10 AS A GRANT FROM THE PROGRAM IN A FISCAL YEAR.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
