## A BILL ENTITLED

Commission to Study African American Civil War Sailors in Maryland

1 AN ACT concerning

- FOR the purpose of establishing the Commission to Study African American Civil War Sailors in Maryland to study the history of the African American sailors who fought for the Union Navy and make certain recommendations regarding a memorial dedicated to African American Civil War sailors; and generally relating to the Commission to Study African American Civil War Sailors in Maryland.
- 8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 9 That:
- 10 (a) There is a Commission to Study African American Civil War Sailors in 11 Maryland.
- 12 (b) The Commission consists of the following members:
- 13 (1) one member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of
- 14 the Senate;

- 15 (2) one member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the
- 16 House; and
- 17 (3) the following members, appointed by the Governor:
- 18 (i) one representative from the State Archives;
- 19 (ii) one representative from the Department of Planning;
- 20 (iii) one representative from the Governor's Commission on 21 Maryland Military Monuments;

6	(c)	The Governor shall designate the chair of the Commission.
7	(d)	The State Archives shall provide staff for the Commission.
8	(e)	A member of the Commission:
9		(1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Commission; but
10 11	(2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.	
12	(f)	The Commission shall:
13 14 15		(1) study the history of African American Civil War sailors who fought for Navy in Maryland, including muster rolls, locations of service, and all I honors and recognitions awarded; and
16 17 18	(2) make findings and recommendations regarding the funding, design, construction, and location of an appropriate memorial dedicated to the African American Civil War sailors in Maryland.	
19 20 21	(g) On or before December 1, 2025, the Commission shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.	
22 23 24 25	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2025. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 2026, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
