3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Maryland Correctional Training  
4 Commission to include the Director *and an employee* of the Division of Parole and

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Correctional Services**

4 8–204.

5 (b) The Commission consists of the following members:

6 (1) the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services;

7 (2) the Secretary of Juvenile Services;

8 (3) a representative of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional  
9 Services, designated by the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services;

10 (4) a representative of the Department of Juvenile Services, designated by  
11 the Secretary of Juvenile Services;

12 (5) a Deputy Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services;

13 (6) the president of the Maryland Correctional Administrators Association;

14 (7) the president of the Maryland Sheriffs Association;

15 (8) the president of the Maryland Criminal Justice Association;

16 (9) the Attorney General of the State;

17 (10) the president of a university or college in the State with a correctional  
18 education curriculum, appointed by the Maryland Higher Education Commission;

19 (11) one correctional officer of the State recommended by the exclusive  
20 representative for the officers covered under Title 10, Subtitle 9 of this article and  
21 appointed by the Governor; **[and]**

22 (12) five correctional officers or officials appointed under subsection (c) of  
23 this section; ~~AND~~

24 **(13) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION**  
25 **WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES; AND**

26 ~~(14) ONE PAROLE AND PROBATION EMPLOYEE OF THE STATE~~  
27 ~~RECOMMENDED BY THE EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE FOR PAROLE AND~~  
28 ~~PROBATION EMPLOYEES, AS SPECIFIED AND APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.~~

1                    **(14) ONE EMPLOYEE OF THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION**  
 2 **RECOMMENDED BY THE EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE**  
 3 **DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION AND APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.**

4                    *(d) Except for the five members appointed by the Governor under subsection (c) of*  
 5 *this section **AND THE MEMBER APPOINTED UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(14) OF THIS***  
 6 ***SECTION, a member of the Commission may serve personally at a Commission meeting or***  
 7 ***designate a representative from the member’s unit or association who may act at any meeting***  
 8 ***to the same effect as if the member were personally present.***

9                    SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
 10 October 1, 2025.
