16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "MAIL OR PACKAGE" MEANS AN ITEM DELIVERED OR 17 LEFT TO BE COLLECTED BY THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OR A DELIVERY 18 SERVICE COMPANY THAT DELIVERS TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY.

19 **(B)** A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY OR WILLFULLY AND WITHOUT 20 PERMISSION OF THE INTENDED RECIPIENT OF THE MAIL OR PACKAGE OBTAIN OR 21 EXERT CONTROL OVER MAIL OR A PACKAGE DELIVERED TO ANOTHER WITH THE 22 INTENT TO DEPRIVE THE OWNER OF THE MAIL OR PACKAGE.
