Article - Criminal Law

20A person may not take and break open a letter that is not addressed to the (a) person without permission from the person to whom the letter is addressed or the personal 2122representative of the addressee's estate.

1 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on 2 conviction:

(1) is subject to imprisonment for 6 days and a fine of \$15; AND

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "MAIL OR PACKAGE" MEANS AN ITEM DELIVERED OR
 LEFT TO BE COLLECTED BY THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OR A DELIVERY
 SERVICE COMPANY THAT DELIVERS TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY.

14 **(B)** A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY OR WILLFULLY AND WITHOUT 15 PERMISSION OF THE INTENDED RECIPIENT OF THE MAIL OR PACKAGE OBTAIN OR 16 EXERT CONTROL OVER MAIL OR A PACKAGE DELIVERED TO OR INTENDED FOR 17 DELIVERY TO ANOTHER WITH THE INTENT TO DEPRIVE THE OTHER OF THE MAIL OR 18 PACKAGE.

19 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND 20 ON CONVICTION:

(1) IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 5 YEARS; AND

22 (2) SHALL PAY ANY ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS RELATED TO 23 SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION.

(D) FOR A CONVICTION UNDER THIS SECTION INVOLVING A LETTER OR
PACKAGE DELIVERED OR INTENDED FOR DELIVERY BY THE UNITED STATES
POSTAL SERVICE, THE COURT SHALL PROMPTLY NOTIFY THE UNITED STATES
POSTMASTER GENERAL OF THE CONVICTION.
