2 Public Safety - Gun Violence Victim Relocation Program - Establishment

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Gun Violence Victim Relocation Program within the 4 Victim Services Unit of the Governor's Office of Crime Prevention and Policy to 5 provide certain victims of gun violence certain services and assistance related to 6 relocating for the safety of the victim or the victim's family; establishing the Gun 7 Violence Victim Relocation Program Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; requiring 8 interest earnings of the Fund to be credited to the Fund; requiring the Victim 9 Services Unit to establish a certain oversight commission; and generally relating to 10 the Gun Violence Victim Relocation Program.



- 19 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE FOR ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE
- 20 **PROGRAM IF:**
- 21 (I) THE INDIVIDUAL IS A VICTIM OF GUN VIOLENCE IN THE
- 22 **STATE**;
- 23 (II) 1. THE INDIVIDUAL EXPERIENCED THE VIOLENCE
- 24 WITHIN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO THE INDIVIDUAL'S HOME; OR
- 25 2. THE INDIVIDUAL LIVES IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO A
- 26 PERSON WHO IS SUSPECTED TO HAVE CAUSED THE VIOLENCE; AND

- 18 (3) PROVIDING OTHER SUPPORT SERVICES, INCLUDING

- 22 (1) COLLABORATE WITH OTHER STATE AND LOCAL AGENCIES,
- 23 INCLUDING LAW ENFORCEMENT, HOUSING AUTHORITIES, AND SOCIAL SERVICES, TO
- 24 PROVIDE COMPREHENSIVE SERVICES TO VICTIMS UNDER THE PROGRAM;
- 25 (2) CONDUCT COMMUNITY OUTREACH IN ORDER TO EDUCATE THE
- 26 PUBLIC ABOUT THE PROGRAM AND TO ENCOURAGE VICTIMS OF GUN VIOLENCE TO
- 27 SEEK ASSISTANCE UNDER THE PROGRAM; AND
- 28 (3) WORK TO ENSURE THAT VICTIMS UNDER THE PROGRAM WHO ARE
- 29 RENTERS ARE PROTECTED FROM EVICTION OR FROM BEING DENIED RENTAL

- 7 (A) THERE IS A GUN VIOLENCE VICTIM RELOCATION PROGRAM FUND.
- 8 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
- 9 SUBTITLE.
- 10 (C) THE VICTIM SERVICES UNIT SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.
- 11 (D) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT
- 12 SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- 13 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY,
- 14 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
- 15 (E) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:
- 16 (1) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;
- 17 (2) PRIVATE DONATIONS; AND
- 18 (3) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR
- 19 THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
- 20 (F) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY FOR CARRYING OUT THE PURPOSE OF
- 21 THE FUND.
- 22 (G) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND
- 23 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.
- 24 (2) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO
- 25 THE FUND.
- 26 (H) NO PART OF THE FUND MAY REVERT OR BE CREDITED TO:

- 2 terms of a gift or settlement agreement, net interest on all State money allocated by the
- 3 State Treasurer under this section to special funds or accounts, and otherwise entitled to

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, for fiscal year 2027, the
- 14 Governor shall include in the annual budget bill an appropriation of \$10,000,000 to the Gun
- 15 Violence Victim Relocation Program Fund established under Title 5, Subtitle 9 of the Public
- 16 Safety Article.
- 17 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 18 1, 2025.
