BY adding to Article – Education Section 7–118 Annotated Code of Maryland (2022 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Education** 7-118. IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS (A) **(1)** INDICATED. "DEBT" MEANS ANY MONEY, OBLIGATION, CLAIM, OR SUM **(2)** (I)DUE OR OWED BY A STUDENT OR FORMER STUDENT TO A NONPUBLIC SCHOOL.

- 1 (II) "DEBT" DOES NOT INCLUDE THE FEE, IF ANY, CHARGED TO 2 A STUDENT FOR THE ACTUAL COSTS OF PROVIDING A TRANSCRIPT.
- 3 (3) "NONPUBLIC SCHOOL" MEANS A NONPUBLIC SCHOOL IN THE 4 STATE THAT PARTICIPATES IN STATE-FUNDED EDUCATION PROGRAMS.
- 5 (4) "STUDENT" INCLUDES CURRENT STUDENTS AND FORMER 6 STUDENTS OF A NONPUBLIC SCHOOL.
- 7 (B) A NONPUBLIC SCHOOL MAY NOT:
- 8 (1) REFUSE TO ISSUE A TRANSCRIPT TO A STUDENT OR THE PARENT 9 OR GUARDIAN OF A STUDENT BECAUSE THE STUDENT OWES A DEBT;
- 10 (2) CONDITION THE ISSUANCE OF A TRANSCRIPT ON THE PAYMENT 11 OF A DEBT;
- 12 (3) CHARGE A HIGHER FEE FOR OBTAINING A TRANSCRIPT BECAUSE 13 THE STUDENT OWES A DEBT;
- 14 (4) PROVIDE LESS FAVORABLE TREATMENT OF A TRANSCRIPT 15 REQUEST BECAUSE A STUDENT OWES A DEBT; OR
- 16 (5) USE TRANSCRIPT ISSUANCE AS A TOOL OF DEBT COLLECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 18 1, 2025.
