 by a new resident of the State who fails to register the vehicle with the Motor Vehicle
 Administration and display valid registration plates issued by the Administration

(a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section or elsewhere in the
 Maryland Vehicle Law, each motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, and pole trailer driven on
 a highway shall be registered under this subtitle.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
