12SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 4 - 414.

16The chief executive and administrative officer of a municipality that (a) (1)17has annexed property shall send a copy of the annexation resolution with the new 18 boundaries to:

(i) the clerk or similar official of the municipality;

20the clerk of the court in any county in which the municipality is (ii) 21located;

1 (iii) the Department of Legislative Services in accordance with 2 paragraph (2) of this subsection; [and]

3 (iv) THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING IN ACCORDANCE WITH 4 PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION; AND

5 (V) for any municipality located in the regional district, the 6 Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

7 (2) The annexation resolution shall be sent to the Department of 8 Legislative Services AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING within 10 days after the 9 resolution takes effect.

10 (b) Each official or agency that receives an annexation resolution under 11 subsection (a) of this section shall:

12 (1) keep on record the resolution with the new boundaries; and

13 (2) make the resolution available for public inspection during regular 14 business hours.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2025.
