16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "SEXUALLY EXPLICIT MATERIALS" MEANS BOOKS AND 17 AUDITORY AND VISUAL MATERIALS THAT CONTAIN GRAPHIC OR OBSCENE 18 DEPICTIONS OF SEXUAL ACTIVITY THAT ARE NOT:

19 (1) AGE-APPROPRIATE; OR

20(2)USED AS PART OF THE APPROVED INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS21FOR INSTRUCTION ON FAMILY LIFE AND HUMAN SEXUALITY AS PART OF THE

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
