F25lr1016  $HB \ 463/24 - APP$ By: Delegate Kerr Introduced and read first time: January 9, 2025 Assigned to: Appropriations A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT concerning Maryland Higher Education Commission – Demographic Data Collection - Parental Status FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Higher Education Commission to collect certain data regarding the parental status of students from each public institution of higher education in the State; requiring public institutions of higher education to collect and report certain demographic data from students; and generally relating to public institutions of higher education and demographic data collection. BY adding to Article – Education Section 11-409 Annotated Code of Maryland (2022 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education 11-409. **(1)** THE COMMISSION SHALL COLLECT DATA FROM EACH PUBLIC (A) INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE ON THE PARENTAL STATUS OF STUDENTS ENROLLED IN EACH INSTITUTION.

THE COMMISSION, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE PUBLIC

INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION, SHALL DEVELOP QUESTIONS THAT ALLOW

**(2)** 

EACH STUDENT TO IDENTIFY:

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- 1 (I) WHETHER THE STUDENT IS A PARENT, ACTING AS A 2 PARENT, OR A LEGAL GUARDIAN;
- 3 (II) THE AGE OF THE CHILDREN FOR WHICH THE STUDENT HAS 4 RESPONSIBILITY; AND
- 5 (III) THE TYPE OF CAREGIVING RESPONSIBILITIES THE 6 STUDENT PROVIDES, INCLUDING WHETHER THE STUDENT:
- 7 1. IS A SINGLE PARENT; OR
- 8 2. SHARES PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITIES WITH 9 SOMEONE IN THE SAME HOUSEHOLD OR A DIFFERENT HOUSEHOLD.
- 10 **(B) (1)** EACH PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL PLACE
  11 THE QUESTIONS DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION ON ONE OR
  12 MORE FORMS THAT ARE USED BY THE INSTITUTION TO COLLECT DEMOGRAPHIC
  13 DATA FROM STUDENTS.
- 14 (2) EACH PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL MAKE 15 THE DATA COLLECTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION AVAILABLE TO 16 THE COMMISSION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FORMAT DETERMINED BY THE
- 17 COMMISSION UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.
- 18 (C) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 19 SECTION, INCLUDING:
- 20 (1) ESTABLISHING A COMMON FORMAT AND TIME FRAME FOR THE 21 COLLECTION AND REPORTING OF THE DATA REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION; AND
- 22 (2) A REQUIREMENT THAT THE COLLECTION OF PARENTAL STATUS
  23 DATA BE INCLUDED WITH THE COLLECTION OF OTHER DEMOGRAPHIC DATA.
- 24 (D) ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1, 2026, AND EACH SEPTEMBER 1
  25 THEREAFTER, THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE SENATE BUDGET
  26 AND TAXATION COMMITTEE, THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION, ENERGY,
  27 AND THE ENVIRONMENT, AND THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE, IN
  28 ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THAT
  29 SUMMARIZES THE DATA COLLECTED BY THE COMMISSION UNDER THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
