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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 **Motor Vehicles – Specially Designed Vintage Reproduction Registration Plates**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the time limitation within which the Motor Vehicle  
4 Administration is required to make available specially designed vintage  
5 reproduction registration plates; requiring the Administration to charge certain fees  
6 for the initial issuance and renewal of specially designed vintage reproduction  
7 registration plates; and generally relating to specially designed vintage reproduction  
8 registration plates.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 16 **Article – Transportation**

17 13–619.3.

18 (a) The Administration shall develop and make available for qualifying vehicles  
19 a specially designed vintage reproduction registration plate.

1 (b) The owner of a vehicle, or a lessee of the vehicle under a lease not intended as  
2 security, or a director, an officer, an employee, or a partner of a business entity that owns  
3 the vehicle considered eligible by the Administration may apply to the Administration for  
4 a registration plate under this section if the vehicle is included in one of the following  
5 classes:

6 (1) A Class A (passenger) vehicle;

7 (2) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a manufacturer's rated capacity of 1 ton  
8 or less;

9 (3) A Class L (historic) vehicle;

10 (4) A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle; or

11 (5) A Class N (street rod) vehicle.

12 (c) (1) In addition to the annual registration fee otherwise required under this  
13 title, an owner of a vehicle assigned a registration plate under this section shall pay [when  
14 initially issued the registration plate and each time the registration plate is renewed:

15 (1) A fee set by the Administration to recover the Administration's costs  
16 under this section; and

17 (2) A fee set by the Administration to be credited to the Gasoline and Motor  
18 Vehicle Revenue Account for distribution under § 8-403 or § 8-404 of this article]:

19 (I) **\$100 WHEN INITIALLY ISSUED THE REGISTRATION PLATE;**  
20 **AND**

21 (II) **\$25 EACH TIME THE REGISTRATION PLATE IS RENEWED.**

22 (2) **FEES COLLECTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE:**

23 (I) **USED TO RECOVER THE ADMINISTRATION'S COSTS UNDER**  
24 **THIS SECTION; AND**

25 (II) **CREDITED TO THE GASOLINE AND MOTOR VEHICLE**  
26 **REVENUE ACCOUNT FOR DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 8-403 OR § 8-404 OF THIS**  
27 **ARTICLE.**

28 (d) The special registration plate issued under this section shall[:

29 (1) Be available for sale for 1 year from the date of initial issuance; and

1                   (2) Resemble] **RESEMBLE** the black lettering on yellow background  
2 registration plate issued by the State for display on a motor vehicle in 1910.

3                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
4 October 1, 2025.
