BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, adding to Article – Transportation Section $\frac{21-507(e)}{21-507.1}$ Annotated Code of Maryland (2020 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Transportation 21 - 507In Calvert County, Carroll County, Charles County, Harford County, [and] Washington County, AND WICOMICO COUNTY, a person may not stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.

 <u>21-507.1.</u>

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "AGGRESSIVE MANNER" MEANS:
(1) Intentionally blocking or interfering with the safe of Free passage of a pedestrian or vehicle by any means, including by unreasonably causing a pedestrian or driver to take evasive action to avoid physical contact; or
(2) <u>Using violent or threatening gestures toward at individual.</u>
(B) IN WICOMICO COUNTY, A PERSON MAY NOT STAND IN A ROADWAY MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR INTERSECTION TO SOLICIT IN AN AGGRESSIVE MANNEY MONEY OR DONATIONS OF ANY KIND FROM AN OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October June 1, 2025.
