## A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 State Buildings and State Highways – Collection and Disposal of Yard Waste

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from disposing of yard waste collected on the grounds of a State building or State highway in a certain container; requiring a person to collect yard waste on the grounds of a State building or State highway in a certain container; requiring all yard waste collected on the grounds of a State building or State highway to be disposed of in a certain manner; and generally relating to the collection and disposal of yard waste from the grounds of State buildings and State highways.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
  That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 SUBTITLE 10. COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF YARD WASTE.

21 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 22 INDICATED.

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1 (B) "NATURAL WOOD WASTE RECYCLING FACILITY" HAS THE MEANING 2 STATED IN § 9–1701 OF THE ENVIRONMENT ARTICLE.

3 (C) "ORGANICS RECYCLING FACILITY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 4 9–1701 OF THE ENVIRONMENT ARTICLE.

5 (D) (1) "STATE BUILDING" MEANS A BUILDING, A STRUCTURE, OR AN 6 IMPROVED AREA THAT IS:

7 (I) OWNED BY THE STATE; OR

8 (II) CONSTRUCTED FOR LEASE BY THE STATE.

9 (2) "STATE BUILDING" INCLUDES:

10 (I) AN EDUCATIONAL FACILITY OWNED OR OPERATED BY THE 11 STATE, INCLUDING PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION;

12(II) A PUBLIC MASS TRANSPORTATION ACCOMMODATION, SUCH13AS A TERMINAL OR STATION, THAT IS SUPPORTED BY STATE FUNDS; AND

14(III) AN IMPROVEMENT OF A PUBLIC AREA USED FOR15GATHERING OR AMUSEMENT, INCLUDING A STATE PARK, RECREATION CENTER, OR16SIMILAR AREA.

17 (E) (1) "STATE HIGHWAY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 8–101 OF THE 18 TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.

19 (2) "STATE HIGHWAY" INCLUDES ANY LAND OWNED BY THE STATE 20 THAT IS ADJACENT TO A STATE HIGHWAY.

21 (F) (1) "YARD WASTE" MEANS ORGANIC PLANT WASTE DERIVED FROM 22 GARDENING, LANDSCAPING, AND TREE TRIMMING ACTIVITIES.

23(2) "YARD WASTE" INCLUDES LEAVES, GARDEN WASTE, LAWN24CUTTINGS, WEEDS, AND PRUNINGS.

25 **2–1002.** 

26 (A) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, 27 THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A PERSON WHO:

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1 (I) IS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE STATE WHO COLLECTS YARD 2 WASTE ON THE GROUNDS OF A STATE BUILDING OR STATE HIGHWAY AS PART OF 3 THAT PERSON'S EMPLOYMENT; OR

4 (II) CONTRACTS WITH THE STATE TO PROVIDE SERVICES ON 5 THE GROUNDS OF A STATE BUILDING OR STATE HIGHWAY, INCLUDING THE 6 COLLECTION OF YARD WASTE.

7 (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO IS DISPOSING 8 OF:

9 (I) NOXIOUS WEEDS, AS DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF 10 AGRICULTURE; OR

11 (II) INVASIVE SPECIES.

12 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT DISPOSE OF YARD WASTE COLLECTED ON THE 13 GROUNDS OF A STATE BUILDING OR STATE HIGHWAY IN A SINGLE-USE PLASTIC 14 CONTAINER.

15 (C) A PERSON SHALL COLLECT YARD WASTE ON THE GROUNDS OF A STATE 16 BUILDING OR STATE HIGHWAY IN A CONTAINER THAT:

- 17 (1) WILL NOT BE DISCARDED WITH THE YARD WASTE; OR
- 18 (2) IS A COMPOSTABLE PAPER BAG.

19 (D) ALL YARD WASTE COLLECTED ON THE GROUNDS OF A STATE BUILDING 20 OR STATE HIGHWAY SHALL BE DISPOSED OF AT:

21 (1) AN ORGANICS RECYCLING FACILITY LOCATED IN THE STATE;

22 (2) A NATURAL WOOD WASTE RECYCLING FACILITY LOCATED IN THE 23 STATE; OR

24 (3) A STATE FACILITY WITH THE ON-SITE CAPACITY TO CREATE 25 MULCH OR SOIL AMENDMENTS.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 27 October 1, 2025.
