BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 3 (F) THE STATE LIBRARY AGENCY SHALL SELECT THE CHILDREN'S BOOKS 4 FOR USE IN THE PROGRAM INCLUDING CHILDREN'S BOOKS IN LANGUAGES OTHER 5 THAN ENGLISH.
- 6 (G) THE STATE LIBRARY AGENCY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE 7 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES AND THE 8 CORRECTIONAL EDUCATION COUNCIL, SHALL:
- 9 (1) ESTABLISH A PROCESS TO SECURE WRITTEN PERMISSION TO
 10 PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM FROM THE CUSTODIAL PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF AN
 11 INCARCERATED INDIVIDUAL'S CHILD;
- 12 (2) ESTABLISH A PROCESS TO ASSIST AN INCARCERATED INDIVIDUAL
 13 IN SELECTING AN AGE-APPROPRIATE CHILDREN'S BOOK, PREPARING A RECORDING
 14 OF THE INCARCERATED INDIVIDUAL READING THE BOOK ALOUD, AND
 15 DISTRIBUTING A COPY OF THE BOOK AND THE RECORDING TO THE INCARCERATED
 16 INDIVIDUAL'S CHILD; AND
- 17 (3) ENSURE PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM IS FREE OF CHARGE 18 FOR THE INCARCERATED INDIVIDUAL, THE CHILD, AND THE CUSTODIAL PARENT OR
- 19 GUARDIAN.
- 20 (H) THE STATE LIBRARY AGENCY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY 21 TO CARRY OUT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 1, 2028, the State Library Agency shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with §
- 24 2-1257 of the State Government Article, on the results of the Family Literacy Pilot
- 25 Program.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- October 1, 2025. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and 3 months and, at the
- 28 end of December 31, 2028, this Act, with no further action required by the General
- 29 Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
