SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – Transportation

16 (a) Every person operating a bicycle or a motor scooter in a public bicycle area 17 has all the rights granted to and is subject to all the duties required of the driver of a vehicle 18 by this title, including the duties set forth in § 21–504 of this title, except:

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As otherwise provided in this subtitle; and

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(2) For those provisions of this title that by their very nature cannot apply.

21 (b) (1) Subject to paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, a person has the 22 rights and is subject to the restrictions applicable to pedestrians under this title while the 23 person is lawfully operating a bicycle, play vehicle, or unicycle:

(2) 13BEFORE ENTERING AN INTERSECTION AS DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A PERSON OPERATING A BICYCLE, PLAY 1415VEHICLE, OR UNICYCLE SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO ANY VEHICLE OR PEDESTRIAN LAWFULLY USING THE INTERSECTION. 16
