- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 16 (a) Every person operating a bicycle or a motor scooter in a public bicycle area
- 17 has all the rights granted to and is subject to all the duties required of the driver of a vehicle
- 18 by this title, including the duties set forth in § 21–504 of this title, except:

(b) (1) Subject to paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, a person has the rights and is subject to the restrictions applicable to pedestrians under this title while the person is lawfully operating a bicycle, play vehicle, or unicycle:
(i) On a sidewalk or sidewalk area; or
(ii) In or through a crosswalk.
(2) [At] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION AT an intersection, a person operating a bicycle, play vehicle, or unicycle is subject to a traffic control signals, as provided in §§ 21–202 and 21–203 of this title.
(3) Section 21–506 of this title does not apply to a person operating bicycle, play vehicle, or unicycle.
(C) (1) UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE A PERSON OPERATING A BICYCLE, PLAY VEHICLE, OR UNICYCLE AT A INTERSECTION WHO IS FACING A RED SIGNAL MAY ENTER THE INTERSECTION TO CROSS THE HIGHWAY IN THE DIRECTION OF A PEDESTRIAN CONTROL "WALK SIGNAL DISPLAYED FOR THE PORTION OF THE HIGHWAY ON WHICH THE BICYCLE PLAY VEHICLE, OR UNICYCLE IS TRAVELING. (2) BEFORE ENTERING AN INTERSECTION AS DESCRIBED IN THE PROPERTY OF THE PROPER
PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A PERSON OPERATING A BICYCLE, PLA VEHICLE, OR UNICYCLE SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO ANY VEHICLE O
PEDESTRIAN LAWFULLY USING THE INTERSECTION.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effe October 1, 2025.
