FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Public Accountancy to place a licensee on emeritus status under certain circumstances; requiring the Board to reinstate the license of an individual who is on emeritus status under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the State Board of Public Accountancy and emeritus status.

- (II) A LICENSEE WHO IS ON EMERITUS STATUS UNDER § 2–313.1 OF THIS TITLE MAY USE THE WORDS "CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT EMERITUS" OR THE ABBREVIATION "CPA EMERITUS" TO DESCRIBE THE OCCUPATION OF THE INDIVIDUAL, PROVIDED THAT THE LICENSEE DOES NOT REPRESENT TO THE PUBLIC THAT THE LICENSEE IS AUTHORIZED TO PRACTICE CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANCY IN THE STATE.
- 8 (2) In a proceeding under this title, evidence of a single representation 9 described in paragraph (1) of this subsection is, without evidence of a general course of 10 conduct, adequate to justify a finding that a person has represented to the public that the 11 person is authorized to practice certified public accountancy in the State.
