- IF THERE IS A DECLINE OR NO GROWTH IN THE CONSUMER PRICE 2324INDEX FOR ALL URBAN CONSUMERS, THE APPROPRIATION REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2526 PRIOR FISCAL YEAR.
