## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County – Vehicle Laws – Prohibition on Roadway Solicitations**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person in St. Mary's County from standing in a roadway,  
4 median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations from the occupant of a  
5 vehicle; and generally relating to roadway solicitations in St. Mary's County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article – Transportation  
8 Section 21–507(c)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (2020 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Transportation**

14 21–507.

15 (c) In Calvert County, Carroll County, Charles County, Harford County, **ST.**  
16 **MARY'S COUNTY**, and Washington County, a person may not stand in a roadway, median  
17 divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a  
18 vehicle.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
20 October 1, 2025.
