A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Agriculture – Roosters – Restrictions**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting, unless authorized by the Department of Agriculture, a
4 certain person from keeping a certain number of roosters on certain property
5 beginning on a certain date, subject to certain exceptions; authorizing the
6 Department to work in cooperation with a local animal control or law enforcement
7 officer to enforce this Act; and generally relating to restrictions on keeping roosters
8 in the State.

14 Preamble

15 WHEREAS, Despite its illegality in Maryland, ongoing issues persist with
16 cockfighting; and

17 WHEREAS, Breeding roosters for cockfighting is directly linked to the spread of
18 Avian Flu; now, therefore,

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Agriculture**

22 **3–105.2.**

1 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
2 INDICATED.

3 (2) “PROPERTY” MEANS:

4 (I) A PARCEL OF LAND; OR

5 (II) A COMBINATION OF PARCELS OF LAND OPERATING AS A
6 SINGLE UNIT.

7 (3) “ROOSTER” MEANS A MALE CHICKEN THAT:

8 (I) IS AT LEAST 6 MONTHS OLD;

9 (II) HAS FULLY DEVELOPED AN ADULT PLUMAGE; OR

10 (III) IS CAPABLE OF CROWING.

11 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:

12 (1) COMMERCIAL POULTRY PRODUCERS, AS DEFINED IN § 8–704.2 OF
13 THIS ARTICLE;

14 (2) A PUBLIC SCHOOL OR NONPUBLIC SCHOOL THAT RECEIVES
15 STATE FUNDS;

16 (3) A GOVERNMENT–OPERATED ANIMAL SHELTER;

17 (4) AN ANIMAL WELFARE ORGANIZATION, AS DEFINED IN § 19–701 OF
18 THE BUSINESS REGULATION ARTICLE; OR

19 (5) A MEMBER OF A 4–H OR FUTURE FARMERS OF AMERICA
20 PROGRAM IF, ON REQUEST OF AN ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER, AN OFFICER OF A
21 COUNTY HUMANE SOCIETY, OR A POLICE OFFICER, THE MEMBER PROVIDES IN
22 WRITING PROOF OF:

23 (I) MEMBERSHIP IN A 4–H OR FUTURE FARMERS OF AMERICA
24 PROGRAM; AND

25 (II) AUTHORIZATION FROM THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE
26 ROOSTERS ARE LOCATED THAT SPECIFIES:

1 1. **THE REASON FOR KEEPING MORE THAN 5 ROOSTERS**
2 **PER ACRE OR MORE THAN 25 ROOSTERS ON A PROPERTY;**

3 2. **THE NUMBER OF ROOSTERS THAT MAY BE KEPT;**

4 3. **THE BREED OF EACH ROOSTER THAT MAY BE KEPT;**

5 4. **THE DURATION OF TIME EACH ROOSTER MAY BE**
6 **KEPT; AND**

7 5. **THE ADDRESS OF THE PROPERTY WHERE EACH**
8 **ROOSTER MAY BE KEPT.**

9 **(C) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2027, UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE**
10 **DEPARTMENT, A PERSON WHO KEEPS ROOSTERS THAT ARE MAINTAINED**
11 **INDIVIDUALLY AND KEPT MOVEMENT-CONSTRAINED THROUGH THE USE OF AN**
12 **ENCLOSURE OR TETHER MAY NOT:**

13 **(1) KEEP MORE THAN 5 ROOSTERS PER ACRE ON A SINGLE**
14 **PROPERTY; OR**

15 **(2) KEEP MORE THAN A TOTAL OF 25 ROOSTERS ON A SINGLE**
16 **PROPERTY.**

17 **(D) (1) THIS SECTION DOES NOT AFFECT THE AUTHORITY OF A COUNTY,**
18 **MUNICIPALITY, OR UNIT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT TO ENACT AND ENFORCE**
19 **STANDARDS OR REQUIREMENTS RELATED TO ROOSTERS THAT ARE MORE**
20 **STRINGENT THAN THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.**

21 **(2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT LIMIT OR SUPERSEDE ANY OTHER**
22 **COUNTY, MUNICIPAL, OR STATE LAW, RULE, OR REGULATION THAT PROVIDES MORE**
23 **STRINGENT REQUIREMENTS REGARDING THE KEEPING OF ROOSTERS.**

24 **(E) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS:**

25 **(1) GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO**
26 **A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000; OR**

27 **(2) SUBJECT TO ENFORCEMENT UNDER § 3-119 OF THIS SUBTITLE.**

28 **(F) THE DEPARTMENT MAY WORK IN COOPERATION WITH A LOCAL ANIMAL**
29 **CONTROL OR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER TO ENFORCE THIS SECTION.**

1 **(G) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO REQUIRE THE**
2 **DEPARTMENT TO CONDUCT ADDITIONAL INSPECTIONS BEYOND THOSE**
3 **INSPECTIONS REQUIRED BY LAW.**

4 **(H) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS**
5 **SECTION.**

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2025.
