- FOR the purpose of authorizing a certain holder of a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license in Anne Arundel County to convert the license to a Class C (veterans' organization) license; altering the annual license fee for a Class C (veterans' organization) license; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County to provide application and administrative fee discounts to certain licensees and applicants; authorizing the holder of a Class C (veterans' organization) license to operate on Sunday without obtaining a Sunday license; and generally relating to alcoholic

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 2 (a) There is a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license.
- 3 (b) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor at retail, 4 at a club at the place described in the license, for on–premises consumption.
- 5 (c) The annual license fee is \$480.
- 6 11–1009.

- 7 (a) There is a Class C (veterans' organization) license.
- 8 (b) The Board shall issue the license for use by a local unit of a nationwide 9 nonprofit organization or club that:
- 10 (1) is composed only of members who served in the armed forces of the 11 United States in a war in which the United States has been engaged;
- 12 (2) has a charter from a national veterans' organization that was granted 13 before the application for the license was made;
- 14 (3) has a bona fide membership of at least 100 individuals and dues of at least \$5 per year per individual; and
- 16 (4) operates for its members and meets in a clubhouse principally used for 17 its members.
- 18 (c) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor at retail at the place described in the license for on–premises consumption.
- 20 (d) The license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor during the hours and days 21 as set out for a Class C [beer, wine, and liquor] (VETERANS' ORGANIZATION) license 22 under § 11–2004 of this title.
- 23 (E) (1) A HOLDER OF A CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE 1SSUED UNDER § 11–903 OF THIS TITLE THAT QUALIFIES AS A VETERANS' ORGANIZATION UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION MAY APPLY TO CONVERT THE LICENSE TO A CLASS C (VETERANS' ORGANIZATION) LICENSE.
- 27 (2) THE CONVERSION TO AND ISSUANCE OF A CLASS C (VETERANS' 28 ORGANIZATION) LICENSE UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE 29 CONSIDERED A LICENSE RENEWAL AND NOT AN ISSUANCE OF A NEW LICENSE.
  - [(e)] **(F) (1)** The annual license fee is [\$400] **\$300**.

- 1 (2) THE BOARD MAY PROVIDE APPLICATION AND ADMINISTRATIVE 2 FEE DISCOUNTS TO AN ORGANIZATION THAT:
- 3 (I) QUALIFIES AS A VETERANS' ORGANIZATION UNDER 4 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- 5 (II) 1. HOLDS A CLASS C (VETERANS' ORGANIZATION) 6 LICENSE;
- 7 2. APPLIES FOR AN INITIAL OR RENEWAL CLASS C 8 (VETERANS' ORGANIZATION) LICENSE; OR
- 9 3. HOLDS A CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE 10 THAT IS CONVERTED TO A CLASS C (VETERANS' ORGANIZATION) LICENSE UNDER 11 SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION.

- 13 (c) (1) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A holder of a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor on Monday through Saturday from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day.
- 16 (2) Except as provided in [paragraph] PARAGRAPHS (3) AND (4) of this subsection, the license holder may not sell beer, wine, or liquor after 2 a.m. on Sunday.
- 18 (3) The Board may issue to the license holder a Sunday license that authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and liquor on Sunday according to terms that the license states.
- 21 (4) A HOLDER OF A CLASS C (VETERANS' ORGANIZATION) LICENSE 22 UNDER § 11–1009 OF THIS TITLE MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ON MONDAY 23 THROUGH SUNDAY FROM 6 A.M. TO 2 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY WITHOUT 24 OBTAINING A SUNDAY LICENSE UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 25 **[**(4)**] (5)** The license holder may sell or provide beer, wine, and liquor at a bar or counter on any day on which the sale of beer, wine, and liquor is allowed by law.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  $1,\,2025.$
