16 (A) (1) EACH HOSPITAL IN THE STATE SHALL PROVIDE PARKING AT NO 17 COST TO:

- 18(I)EACH INPATIENT FOR THE DURATION OF THE INPATIENT'S19ADMISSION; AND
- 20(II)EACH OUTPATIENT ATTENDING A SCHEDULED MEDICAL21APPOINTMENT FOR THE DURATION OF THE APPOINTMENT.

1 (2) PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO EACH PARKING 2 FACILITY OWNED, OPERATED, OR LEASED BY THE HOSPITAL AT WHICH THE 3 INPATIENT OR OUTPATIENT IS RECEIVING SERVICES.

4 (B) EACH HOSPITAL SHALL DISPLAY SIGNAGE AT EACH PUBLIC ENTRANCE 5 AND PARKING FACILITY INFORMING INPATIENTS AND OUTPATIENTS OF THE 6 AVAILABILITY OF PARKING AT NO COST.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2025.
