19	(c) In BALTIMORE COUNTY AND Calvert County, a police officer may enforce
20	the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law on a private roadway in [Calvert County] THE

- 1 (b) (1) A person may not drive a motor vehicle in violation of any provision of 2 this title on any private property that is used by the public in general, or, in **BALTIMORE** 3 **COUNTY AND** Calvert County, on any private [road] **ROADWAY** located within a 4 residential subdivision or community.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2025.
