8 (3) ANY COST SAVINGS ACHIEVED BY THE PROGRAM DURING THE 9 IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR ASSOCIATED WITH THE USE OF THE HOME 10 BLOOD PRESSURE MONITORS DISTRIBUTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 12 1, 2025.
