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1(c)The Program shall develop and implement an education2CAMPAIGN TO INFORM ELIGIBLE PROGRAM RECIPIENTS AND HEALTH CARE3PROVIDERS ABOUT THE BENEFITS AND USAGE OF BLOOD PRESSURE MONITORING4TECHNOLOGY AND THE AVAILABILITY OF ASSISTANCE WITH SETUP AND5TROUBLESHOOTING.

6 (D) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, BEGINNING IN 2027, THE 7 DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE AND 8 THE HOUSE HEALTH AND GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS COMMITTEE, IN 9 ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THAT 10 INCLUDES:
