- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Pharmacy to send renewal notices to
- licensees, permit holders, and registrants by electronic means, rather than
- first-class mail, unless the licensee, permit holder, or registrant requests to receive
- 6 the renewal notice by first-class mail; and generally relating to renewal notices sent
- 7 by the State Board of Pharmacy.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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
- 23 (a) (1) A license expires on the date set by the Board unless it is renewed for
- 24 an additional term as provided in this section.

1 (2) A license may not be renewed for a term longer than 2 years. 2 Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the Board shall (1) 3 send to each licensee, at least 1 month before a license expires, a renewal notice by [first-class mail] **ELECTRONIC MEANS** to the last known **E-MAIL** address of the licensee. 4 5 (2)If requested by a licensee, the Board shall send to the licensee, at least 6 two times within the month before a license expires, a renewal notice by [electronic means] 7 FIRST-CLASS MAIL to the last known [electronic] address of the licensee. 8 If a renewal notice sent by electronic means under paragraph [(2)] (1) 9 of this subsection is returned to the Board as undeliverable, the Board shall send to the 10 licensee a renewal notice by first-class mail to the last known address of the licensee. 11 (4) A renewal notice sent under this subsection shall state: 12 (i) The date on which the current license expires; 13 The date by which the renewal application must be received by the Board for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and 14 The amount of the renewal fee. 15 (iii) 12-407.16 17 A pharmacy permit expires on the May 31 after its effective date, unless the 18 pharmacy permit is renewed for a 2-year term as provided in this section. Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, on or before 19 (b) 20 March 1 of the year the permit expires, the Board shall send to each pharmacy permit 21holder a renewal notice for each pharmacy permit by [first-class mail] ELECTRONIC 22**MEANS** to the last known **E-MAIL** address of the pharmacy permit holder. 23If requested by a pharmacy permit holder, the Board shall send to the 24pharmacy permit holder, at least two times within the month before a pharmacy permit 25expires, a renewal notice for each pharmacy permit by [electronic means] FIRST-CLASS 26 MAIL to the last known [electronic] address of the pharmacy permit holder. 27 If a renewal notice sent by electronic means under paragraph [(2)] (1) 28of this subsection is returned to the Board as undeliverable, the Board shall send to the 29 pharmacy permit holder a renewal notice for each pharmacy permit by first-class mail to 30 the last known address of the pharmacy permit holder. 31 **(4)** A renewal notice sent under this subsection shall state:

The date on which the current pharmacy permit expires;

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- 1 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, at least 1 month 2 before a wholesale distributor permit expires, the Board shall send to the wholesale 3 distributor permit holder a renewal notice by [first-class mail] ELECTRONIC MEANS to 4 the last known E-MAIL address of the permit holder.
  - (2) If requested by a wholesale distributor permit holder, the Board shall send to the permit holder[, at least two times within the month before a wholesale distributor permit expires,] a renewal notice by [electronic means] FIRST-CLASS MAIL to the last known [electronic] address of the permit holder.
- 9 (3) If a renewal notice sent by electronic means under paragraph [(2)] (1) of this subsection is returned to the Board as undeliverable, the Board shall send to the 11 wholesale distributor permit holder a renewal notice by first—class mail to the last known 12 address of the permit holder.
- 13 12–6D–09.
- 14 (a) (1) Registration expires on the date set by the Board.
- 15 (2) Registration is valid for up to 2 years from the date of issue.
- 16 (b) (1) A registered pharmacy intern who qualified for registration under § 12–6D–03(a)(1) and (2) of this subtitle may renew the registration one time if the registered pharmacy intern [is]:
- 19 (i) Otherwise IS entitled to be registered as a pharmacy intern;
- 20 (ii) Submits to the Board a renewal application on the form that the 21 Board requires; and
- 22 (iii) Pays to the Board a renewal fee set by the Board.
- 23 (2) A registered pharmacy intern who qualified for registration under  $\$  24 12-6D-03(a)(3) and (4) of this subtitle may not renew the registration.
- 25 (c) The registration of a pharmacy intern registered under this subtitle expires 26 and may not be renewed on the date that the registered pharmacy intern becomes a licensed 27 pharmacist.
- (d) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the Board shall send to each registered pharmacy intern, at least 1 month before a registration expires, a renewal notice by [first-class mail] ELECTRONIC MEANS to the last known E-MAIL address of the registered pharmacy intern.

- 1 (2) If requested by a registered pharmacy intern, the Board shall send to 2 the registered pharmacy intern[, at least two times within the month before a pharmacy 3 intern registration expires,] a renewal notice by [electronic means] FIRST-CLASS MAIL to 4 the last known [electronic] address of the registered pharmacy intern.
  - (3) If a renewal notice sent by electronic means under paragraph [(2)] (1) of this subsection is returned to the Board as undeliverable, the Board shall send the registered pharmacy intern a renewal notice by first—class mail to the last known address of the registered pharmacy intern.
- 9 (4) A renewal notice sent under this subsection shall state:
- 10 (i) The date on which the current registration expires;
- 11 (ii) The date by which the renewal application shall be received by 12 the Board for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the registration expires; and
- 13 (iii) The amount of the renewal fee.

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- 14 (e) The Board shall renew the registration of each pharmacy intern who meets 15 the requirements of this section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 October 1, 2025.
