1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Dorchester County – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses – Fees**

3 FOR the purpose of altering licensing fees for certain alcoholic beverages licenses in
4 Dorchester County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Dorchester
5 County to charge an application or transfer fee under certain circumstances; and
6 generally relating to alcoholic beverages license, application, and transfer fees in
7 Dorchester County.

3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
4 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis**

6 19–102.

7 This title applies only in Dorchester County.

8 19–601.

9 (a) There is a Class A beer license.

10 (c) The annual license fee is [~~\$200~~] **\$250**.

11 19–603.

12 (a) There is a Class C beer license.

13 (c) The annual license fee is [~~\$250~~] **\$150**.

14 19–802.

15 (a) There is a Class A beer and wine license.

16 (c) The annual license fee is [~~\$250~~] **\$350**.

17 19–803.

18 (a) There is a Class B beer and wine license.

19 (c) The annual license fee is [~~\$300~~] **\$350**.

20 19–804.

21 (a) There is a Class C beer and wine license.

22 (c) The annual license fee is [~~\$150~~] **\$250**.

23 19–805.

24 (a) There is a Class D beer and wine license.

1 (d) The annual license fee is [~~\$275~~] **\$350**.

2 19-902.

3 (a) There is a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license.

4 (d) The annual license fee is [~~\$1,000~~] **\$1,250**.

5 19-1201.

6 (a) There is a Class B caterer's license.

7 (f) The annual license fee is [~~\$150~~] **\$200**.

8 19-1309.

9 (a) There is a Class C per diem beer and a Class C per diem beer and wine license.

10 (c) The fee for a Class C per diem beer license or Class C per diem beer and wine
11 license is [~~\$15~~] **\$25** per day.

12 19-1310.

13 (a) There is a Class C per diem beer, wine, and liquor license.

14 (c) The fee for the license is [~~\$25~~] **\$35** per day.

15 **19-1408.**

16 (A) (1) **IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER FEE REQUIRED FOR A LICENSE, THE**
17 **BOARD MAY CHARGE AN APPLICATION FEE FOR A NEW LICENSE IN THE AMOUNT OF:**

18 (I) **\$150 FOR AN APPLICATION FOR A CLASS A, CLASS B, CLASS**
19 **C, OR CLASS D BEER AND WINE LICENSE; AND**

20 (II) **\$200 FOR AN APPLICATION FOR A CLASS A, CLASS B, CLASS**
21 **C, OR CLASS D BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE.**

22 (2) **THE APPLICATION FEE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS**
23 **NONREFUNDABLE WHETHER THE LICENSE IS ISSUED OR DENIED.**

24 (3) **THE APPLICATION FEE DOES NOT APPLY TO THE RENEWAL OR**
25 **TRANSFER OF A LICENSE FOR THE SAME PREMISES.**

1 **(B) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER FEE REQUIRED FOR A LICENSE, THE BOARD**
2 **MAY CHARGE A TRANSFER FEE OF \$50 PER LICENSE TRANSFER.**

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
4 1, 2025.
