- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis

HOUSE BILL 568

1 (a) (1) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Board may not 2 issue a new license for an establishment that is within 300 feet in a direct line of a place of 3 worship or a public or nonpublic kindergarten, elementary, or secondary school.

4 (2) The distance from the establishment to the place of worship or the 5 public or nonpublic kindergarten, elementary, or secondary school is to be measured from 6 the establishment in a direct line to the nearest point of the main building of the place of 7 worship or school.

- 8 (b) The prohibition against issuing a license in subsection (a) of this section does 9 not apply to the issuance of:
- 10

(1) a license for a premises that was licensed on October 1, 1996;

11 (2) a Class B (on-sale) beer, wine, and liquor license for a premises in 12 Cambridge, Secretary, or Hurlock; [or]

13 (3) a temporary license; **OR**

14 (4) A LICENSE IF THE BOARD RECEIVES WRITTEN CONSENT TO THE 15 ISSUANCE OF THE LICENSE FROM EACH PLACE OF WORSHIP OR SCHOOL LOCATED 16 WITHIN **300** FEET IN A DIRECT LINE OF THE ESTABLISHMENT FOR WHICH THE 17 LICENSE IS SOUGHT.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2025.
