## A BILL ENTITLED

4	FOR the purpose of establishing an event permit in Anne Arundel County; authorizing the
5	Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County to issue an event permit
6	only to a holder of a Class C (veterans' organization) license; authorizing the permit
7	holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor to certain individuals for on-premises
8	consumption during events held at the licensed premises; and generally relating to
9	alcoholic beverages licenses in Anne Arundel County.

20	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21	That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
22	Article - Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis

- 2 (a) There is a Class C (veterans' organization) license.
- 3 (b) The Board shall issue the license for use by a local unit of a nationwide 4 nonprofit organization or club that:
- 5 (1) is composed only of members who served in the armed forces of the 6 United States in a war in which the United States has been engaged;
- 7 (2) has a charter from a national veterans' organization that was granted 8 before the application for the license was made;
- 9 (3) has a bona fide membership of at least 100 individuals and dues of at least \$5 per year per individual; and
- 11 (4) operates for its members and meets in a clubhouse principally used for 12 its members.
- 13 (c) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor at retail at the place described in the license for on–premises consumption.
- 15 (d) The license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor during the hours and days 16 as set out for a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license under § 11–2004 of this title.
- 17 (e) The annual license fee is \$400.
- 18 **(F) (1)** THERE IS AN EVENT PERMIT.
- 19 (2) (I) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE PERMIT ONLY TO A HOLDER OF 20 A CLASS C (VETERANS' ORGANIZATION) LICENSE ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS 21 SECTION.
- 22 (II) AN APPLICANT FOR THE PERMIT SHALL COMPLETE THE 23 FORM THAT THE BOARD PROVIDES.
- 24 (3) THE PERMIT AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER OF A CLASS C 25 (VETERANS' ORGANIZATION) LICENSE TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES THAT ARE 26 ALLOWED UNDER THE LICENSE:
- 27 (I) DURING AN EVENT HELD ON THE LICENSED PREMISES;
- 28 (II) TO AN INDIVIDUAL ATTENDING THE EVENT, INCLUDING AN 29 INDIVIDUAL WHO IS NOT A MEMBER OF THE VETERANS' ORGANIZATION; AND

- 1 (III) FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION.
- 2 (4) THE ANNUAL PERMIT FEE IS \$100.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 4  $\,$  1, 2025.
