- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Dental Examiners to approve a certain 5 course of study for expanded function dental assistant certification; requiring that a 6 course of study for initial dental assistant certification include an option for an online 7 course of study when appropriate; requiring the Board to reinstate an expired 8 expanded function dental assistant certification only under certain circumstances; 9 requiring the Board to adopt certain regulations relating to continuing education for expanded function dental assistants; and generally relating to expanded function 10 11 dental assistants.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
