- 3 (b) To obtain a high school diploma under subsection (a) of this section, the 4 individual shall apply to the county board in the county where the individual resides or 5 where the school from which the individual withdrew was located.
- 6 (c) Each county board shall adopt rules and regulations to establish procedures 7 for awarding diplomas under this section.
