(JJ) A PROSECUTION OR SUIT FOR ENFORCEMENT OF A LOCAL CONSUMER PROTECTION CODE FOR WHICH EQUITABLE RELIEF, A FINE, OR A PENALTY IS PROVIDED SHALL BE INSTITUTED WITHIN 3 YEARS AFTER LOCAL AUTHORITIES KNEW OR REASONABLY SHOULD HAVE KNOWN OF THE VIOLATION.
