CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

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Public Libraries – Automated External Defibrillator Program (Raymono A. Russell Act)

4 FOR the purpose of requiring operators of certain libraries, beginning on a certain date, to place an automated external defibrillator in a certain area, maintain the 5 6 functionality of the automated external defibrillator, and ensure a trained individual 7 is present under certain circumstances comply with the Public Access Automated External Defibrillator Program; granting certain immunities to libraries and 8 9 individuals for certain acts or omissions under certain circumstances; altering the 10 definition of "facility" for the purpose of excluding certain libraries from the Public 11 Access Automated External Defibrillator Program; requiring the Maryland Department of Health and the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services 12 Systems jointly to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to an automated 13 external defibrillator program for libraries. 14
