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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Real Property – New Home Sales – Entry of Final Sale Price in Multiple Listing**  
3 **Service**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a developer, builder, broker, or real estate agent to enter the  
5 final sale price of a new home into a multiple listing service or similarly accessible  
6 database; and generally relating to the sale of new homes.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Real Property**

15 **10–804.**

16 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “MULTIPLE LISTING SERVICE” MEANS A DATABASE**  
17 **USED BY REAL ESTATE PROFESSIONALS TO FACILITATE THE SALE OF REAL**  
18 **PROPERTY, INCLUDING USE IN THE PREPARATION OF MARKET EVALUATIONS AND**  
19 **APPRAISALS.**

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EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1           **(B) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE SALE OF A NEW HOME IN THE STATE, A**  
2 **DEVELOPER, BUILDER, BROKER, OR REAL ESTATE AGENT SHALL ENTER THE FINAL**  
3 **SALE PRICE OF THE NEW HOME INTO A MULTIPLE LISTING SERVICE OR SIMILARLY**  
4 **ACCESSIBLE DATABASE.**

5           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
6 October 1, 2025.
