- 4 FOR the purpose of establishing a temporary to—go event permit in Wicomico County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Wicomico County to issue a 5 6 temporary to—go event permit to a holder of a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license 7 under certain circumstances; establishing a Class C per diem municipal to-go beer, wine, and liquor license in the county; authorizing the Board to issue a Class C per 8 9 diem municipal to-go beer, wine, and liquor license to a municipality in the county; 10 requiring the Board to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to alcoholic 11 beverages in Wicomico County.


