- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

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17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "PARENTALLY-PLACED PRIVATE SCHOOL 18 STUDENT" MEANS A CHILD WITH A DISABILITY ENROLLED BY THE PARENT OR 19 GUARDIAN OF THE CHILD IN A PRIVATE ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL OR

7 [(a)] (B) (1) Each county board shall develop and publish on its website a list
8 of all special education service delivery models [in]:

9 (I) IN the local school system; AND

10(II) PROVIDED TO PARENTALLY-PLACED PRIVATE SCHOOL11STUDENTS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM.

(2) The county board shall clearly state that all decisions regarding the placement of a child with a disability in a special education service delivery model under paragraph [(1)] (1)(I) of this subsection will be made by an individualized education program team in consultation with the parents or guardians of the child and consistent with the least restrictive environment requirements of the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.

18 [(b)] (C) On request, the county board shall provide a written copy of the 19 information provided under subsection [(a)] (B) of this section.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 21 1, 2025.
