2 **Vehicle Laws – Licenses, Identification Cards, and Moped Operator’s Permits –**
3 **Notation of Nonapparent Disability**
4 **(Eric’s ID Law)**

5 FOR the purpose of requiring that certain applications for a license, an identification card,
6 or a moped operator’s permit allow an applicant to choose to indicate on the
7 document the applicant’s nonapparent disability; requiring the Motor Vehicle
8 Administration to ensure that the license, identification card, or moped operator’s
9 permit of an applicant who indicates that the applicant has a nonapparent disability

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Transportation**

22 11–128.

23 (a) “License”, as used in reference to the operation of a motor vehicle, means any:

24 (1) Driver's license; and

25 (2) Any other license or permit to drive a motor vehicle that is issued under
 26 or granted by the laws of this State, including:

27 (i) Any temporary license;

28 (ii) A learner's instructional permit;

29 (iii) A provisional license;

30 (iv) The privilege of any individual to drive a motor vehicle, whether
 31 or not that individual is formally licensed by this or any other jurisdiction;

32 (v) Any nonresident's privilege to drive, as defined in this subtitle;
 33 and

1 (vi) A commercial driver's license.

2 (b) "License" does not include an electronic credential issued under Title 16,
3 Subtitle 10 of this article.

5 (a) (1) "Motor vehicle" means, except as provided in subsection (b) of this
6 section, a vehicle that:

7 (i) Is self-propelled or propelled by electric power obtained from
8 overhead electrical wires; and

9 (ii) Is not operated on rails.

10 (2) "Motor vehicle" includes a low speed vehicle.

11 (b) "Motor vehicle" does not include:

12 (1) A moped, as defined in § 11-134.1 of this subtitle;

13 (2) A motor scooter, as defined in § 11-134.5 of this subtitle;

14 (3) An electric bicycle, as defined in § 11-117.1 of this subtitle;

15 (4) An electric low speed scooter, as defined in § 11-117.2 of this subtitle;

17 (5) A personal delivery device, as defined in § 21-104.5 of this article.

19 **(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "NONAPPARENT DISABILITY" MEANS A**
20 **DISABILITY OR HEALTH CONDITION THAT IS NOT IMMEDIATELY OBVIOUS OR**
21 **VISIBLE.**

22 **(2) "NONAPPARENT DISABILITY" INCLUDES:**

23 **(I) DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES; AND**

24 **(II) INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES.**

25 **(B) AN INITIAL AND A RENEWAL APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE, AN**
26 **IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR A MOPED OPERATOR'S PERMIT SHALL ALLOW AN**
27 **APPLICANT TO CHOOSE TO INDICATE ON THE DOCUMENT THAT THE APPLICANT HAS**
28 **A NONAPPARENT DISABILITY.**

1 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:

2 (1) ENSURE THAT THE LICENSE, IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR MOPED
3 OPERATOR'S PERMIT OF AN APPLICANT WHO HAS INDICATED A NONAPPARENT
4 DISABILITY ON AN APPLICATION INCLUDES A NOTATION OF THE NONAPPARENT
5 DISABILITY ON THE BOTTOM OF THE LICENSE, IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR MOPED
6 OPERATOR'S PERMIT;

7 (2) CONSULT WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY AND
8 INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY ADVOCACY GROUPS WITH RESPECT TO THE DESIGN OF
9 THE NONAPPARENT DISABILITY NOTATION;

10 (3) NOTIFY AN INDIVIDUAL WITH A NONAPPARENT DISABILITY
11 NOTATION ON A LICENSE, IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR MOPED OPERATOR'S PERMIT
12 THAT TURNS 18 YEARS OF AGE THAT THE INDIVIDUAL MAY REQUEST THAT THE
13 NONAPPARENT DISABILITY NOTATION BE REMOVED; ~~AND~~

14 (4) DELETE ANY RECORD OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S NONAPPARENT
15 DISABILITY NOTATION ON REQUEST BY THE INDIVIDUAL AT ANY TIME; AND

16 (5) ESTABLISH PUBLIC OUTREACH EFFORTS TO EDUCATE THE
17 GENERAL PUBLIC ON THE AVAILABILITY OF THE NONAPPARENT DISABILITY
18 NOTATION.

19 (D) THERE IS NO FEE FOR A NONAPPARENT DISABILITY NOTATION ON A
20 LICENSE, IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR MOPED OPERATOR'S PERMIT, INCLUDING FOR
21 THE ISSUANCE OF A CORRECTED DOCUMENT IF NO OTHER CORRECTIONS ARE MADE.

22 (E) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT:

23 (1) REQUIRE AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE, AN IDENTIFICATION
24 CARD, OR A MOPED OPERATOR'S PERMIT TO PROVIDE PROOF OF THE APPLICANT'S
25 NONAPPARENT DISABILITY;

26 (2) DENY AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE, AN IDENTIFICATION
27 CARD, OR A MOPED OPERATOR'S PERMIT BECAUSE THE NONAPPARENT DISABILITY
28 SELECTED BY THE APPLICANT DOES NOT MATCH THE NONAPPARENT DISABILITY
29 INDICATED ON ANOTHER DOCUMENT ASSOCIATED WITH THE APPLICANT;

30 (3) NOTWITHSTANDING § 4-320 OF THE GENERAL PROVISIONS
31 ARTICLE AND EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION, DISCLOSE
32 FOR ANY USE WITHOUT A COURT ORDER INFORMATION RELATED TO AN
33 APPLICANT'S INDICATION;

1 **(I) INDICATION OF A NONAPPARENT DISABILITY ON AN**
2 **APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE, AN IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR A MOPED OPERATOR'S**
3 **PERMIT ~~FOR ANY USE IN RESPONSE TO A REQUEST FROM AN INSURANCE COMPANY~~**
4 **~~OR THE MARYLAND INSURANCE ADMINISTRATION; OR~~**

5 **(II) REQUEST TO REMOVE AN INDICATION OF A NONAPPARENT**
6 **DISABILITY FROM A LICENSE, AN IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR A MOPED OPERATOR'S**
7 **PERMIT; OR**

8 **(4) USE INFORMATION DISCLOSED BY A PERSON UNDER THIS**
9 **SECTION AS A BASIS FOR REFERRING THE PERSON TO THE MEDICAL ADVISORY**
10 **BOARD UNDER § 16-118 OF THIS ARTICLE.**

11 **(F) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY MAKE INFORMATION DESCRIBED IN**
12 **SUBSECTION (E)(3) OF THIS SECTION AVAILABLE TO:**

13 **(1) A COURT;**

14 **(2) A CRIMINAL JUSTICE AGENCY;**

15 **(3) A DRIVER LICENSING AUTHORITY;**

16 **(4) THE APPLICANT;**

17 **(5) THE APPLICANT'S ATTORNEY;**

18 **(6) ANY THIRD PARTY DESIGNATED BY THE APPLICANT; OR**

19 **(7) THE CHILD SUPPORT ADMINISTRATION.**

20 **(G) THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING AND STANDARDS COMMISSION, IN**
21 **CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE AND OTHER**
22 **INTERESTED STAKEHOLDERS, SHALL ~~IMMEDIATELY~~ IMPLEMENT TRAINING**
23 **CONCERNING INTERACTIONS WITH INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE A NONAPPARENT**
24 **DISABILITY NOTATION ON THEIR LICENSE, IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR MOPED**
25 **OPERATOR'S PERMIT.**
