- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis
- 20 22–102.
- 21 This title applies only in Harford County.
- 22 22–1601.

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1 (a) For every [4,000] **4,750** individuals in the county, as specified by the 2 Maryland Department of Health, the Board may not issue more than:

- 3 (1) one Class A (off–sale) license;
- 4 (2) one Class A–1 (off–sale) license; or
- 5 (3) one Class A–2 (off–sale) license.

6 (b) If the number of licenses in a class exceeds the quota specified in subsection 7 (a) of this section, the Board may not issue a new license of that class unless the number of 8 licenses of that class are reduced by revocation or surrender, creating a vacancy under the 9 particular quota specified.

10 (c) This section does not apply to the transfer, conversion, or renewal of a license.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 12 1, 2025.
