1 AN ACT concerning

Natural Resources – Repeal of Somers Cove Marina Commission and Improvement Fund and Alteration of Operations

FOR the purpose of repealing provisions of law relating to the Somers Cove Marina 4 5 Commission, the Somers Cove Marina Improvement Fund, and the operation of 6 Somers Cove Marina; authorizing the Secretary of Natural Resources to execute 7 certain leases, procure and execute certain contracts, and employ certain staff, and 8 assess certain fees; requiring the Secretary to set the compensation for certain 9 employees under certain circumstances; establishing the Somers Cove Marina 10 Advisory Commission to advise the Secretary on certain matters relating to the Somers Cove Marina; requiring certain revenue received by the Department of 11 12 Natural Resources to be deposited into the Natural Resources Property Maintenance Fund; altering the uses of the Natural Resources Property Maintenance Fund; 13 requiring interest earnings of the Natural Resources Property Maintenance Fund to 14 be credited to that Fund; and generally relating to Somers Cove Marina. 15




