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State Board of Dental Examiners – Applicants Licensed or Certified in Another State

FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Dental Examiners to issue a license or certification to certain applicants licensed or certified by another state within a certain amount of time; requiring that a dental radiation technologist certified in another state be issued a certification by the State Board under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the issuance of licenses and certifications by the State Board of Dental Examiners to applicants licensed or certified in another state.

The qualifications required of applicants for Board certification as a dental

radiation technologist shall include requirements established by:

APPLICANT'S CERTIFICATION, AND HAS NOT BEEN DISCIPLINED BY A DISCIPLINARY

- 2 OR DISCIPLINED BY A COURT OF ANY STATE OR COUNTRY FOR AN ACT THAT WOULD
- 3 BE GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER § 4–315 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- 4 (IV) HAS NOT PREVIOUSLY FAILED AN EXAMINATION FOR 5 CERTIFICATION AS A DENTAL RADIATION TECHNOLOGIST IN THIS STATE.
- 6 (B) If AN APPLICANT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION 7 UNDER THIS SECTION, THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE THE CERTIFICATE WITHIN 15 8 BUSINESS DAYS AFTER RECEIVING THE COMPLETED APPLICATION.
- 9 (C) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT ANY REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE 10 FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF INDIVIDUALS WHO APPLY FOR A CERTIFICATION TO 11 PRACTICE DENTAL RADIATION THERAPY UNDER THIS SECTION.
