- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 17 (I) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE COMMISSION
- 18 MAY NOT APPROVE A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY FOR
- 19 A SOLAR ENERGY GENERATING STATION UNLESS EACH COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL
- 20 CORPORATION WHERE ANY PORTION OF THE GENERATING STATION IS PROPOSED
