15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16	That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19	(A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE GOVERNING BODY
20	OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY MAY APPROVE A PROJECT WITHIN THE

JURISDICTION OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY THAT WAS PREVIOUSLY DENIED

BY THE MARYLAND HISTORICAL TRUST AS A RESULT OF:



- 1 (1) THE PROTECTION OF CEMETERIES UNDER § 14–121.1 OF THE 2 REAL PROPERTY ARTICLE; OR
- 3 (2) THE FOLLOWING FUNCTIONS UNDER TITLE **5A**, SUBTITLE **3** OF 4 THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE:
- 5 (I) HISTORIC PRESERVATION REVIEW FOR STATE PROJECTS;

6 **OR** 

- 7 (II) PERMITTING FOR TERRESTRIAL OR SUBMERGED 8 ARCHAEOLOGICAL INVESTIGATIONS.
- 9 **(B) (1) O**N REQUEST OF A PROJECT APPLICANT, A LOCAL PLANNING 10 COMMISSION SHALL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROJECT.
- 11 (2) THE LOCAL PLANNING COMMISSION SHALL:
- 12 (I) HOLD THE PUBLIC HEARING WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE 13 DATE ON WHICH THE APPLICANT REQUESTS THE HEARING;
- 14 (II) PUBLISH NOTICE OF THE HEARING AT LEAST ONCE IN A
- 15 NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY AND ON
- 16 THE PLANNING COMMISSION'S WEBSITE; AND
- 17 (III) MAKE A RECOMMENDATION TO THE GOVERNING BODY OF 18 THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY ON WHETHER TO APPROVE THE PROJECT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2025.
