HOUSE BILL 771

1 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A PROGRAM FOR STUDENT 2 DENTAL HEALTH.

3 (B) THE DEPARTMENT'S PROGRAM SHALL INCLUDE:

4 (1) STANDARDS FOR THE <u>RECOMMENDED</u> PERIODIC DENTAL 5 EXAMINATIONS OF STUDENTS; <u>AND</u>

6 (2) THE CREATION OF A CERTIFICATE OF DENTAL HEALTH THAT CAN
7 BE USED BY PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 7–402.1 OF THE EDUCATION
8 ARTICLE;

9 (3) THE CREATION OF A STANDARD FORM TO BE USED BY HEALTH 10 CARE PRACTITIONERS, PARENTS, AND SCHOOLS TO CERTIFY A STUDENT'S DENTAL 11 HEALTH; AND

12 (4) INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS AND PARENTS ON:

13(I)How to find insurance that will cover dental14HEALTH CARE;

15 (II) LISTS OF PEDIATRIC DENTISTS LOCATED IN AREAS 16 <u>DIFFERENT REGIONS OF THE STATE</u>; AND

17 (III) THE IMPORTANCE OF DENTAL HEALTH TO A STUDENT'S 18 OVERALL HEALTH AND WELL–BEING.

(C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IMPLEMENT ITS PROGRAM ON A SCHEDULE
THAT ALLOWS EACH STUDENT TO SUBMIT A CERTIFICATE OF DENTAL HEALTH TO
THE STUDENT'S PUBLIC SCHOOL BEGINNING IN THE 2027–2028 SCHOOL YEAR, IN
ACCORDANCE WITH § 7–402.1 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

23 (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 24 SECTION.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 2025.
