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## **Opioid Restitution Fund – Interactive Dashboard**

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Office of Overdose Response, in collaboration with the Maryland Department of Health, to develop and maintain an interactive 4  $\mathbf{5}$ dashboard on Opioid Restitution Fund spending to share prescription opioid-related 6 settlement information with the public; requiring the dashboard to include links to 7 the State, county, or municipal websites that provide access to additional 8 information on the use of opioid-related settlement funds; requiring counties and 9 municipalities receiving settlement funding to provide certain information to the 10 Department to include on the dashboard in a certain manner; requiring that the dashboard be developed and maintained using funds from the Opioid Restitution 11 12Fund appropriated through the State budget; and generally relating to an interactive 13 dashboard on Opioid Restitution Fund spending.

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SHARES THE DATA IN THE REPORTS REQUIRED UNDER AN 1 (II)  $\mathbf{2}$ OPIOID-RELATED SETTLEMENT WITH THE APPROPRIATE STATE ENTITY. 3 (2) A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY RECEIVING SETTLEMENT FUNDS SHALL PROVIDE TO THE DEPARTMENT THE NECESSARY FINANCIAL INFORMATION 4 RELATED TO SETTLEMENT FUNDING TO INCLUDE AS INFORMATION ON THE  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 DASHBOARD. 7 <del>(2)</del> (3) INFORMATION REQUIRED TO BE PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE 8 TERMS OF ANY OPIOID-RELATED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT. 9 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL UPLOAD OPIOID-RELATED 10 <del>(3)</del> (4) SETTLEMENT INFORMATION SUBMITTED TO THE DEPARTMENT BY A COUNTY OR 11 12MUNICIPALITY IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE TERMS OF AN OPIOID-RELATED 13SETTLEMENT. 14THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AN ONLINE PORTAL WITH (5) 15INSTRUCTIONS FOR A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY TO REPORT OR UPLOAD REQUIRED INFORMATION TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR USE IN THE DASHBOARD. 16 **(E)** 17TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, THE DASHBOARD SHALL USE EXISTING PLATFORMS THAT PROVIDE DATA ON OPIOID USE AND OVERDOSES IN THE STATE. 18 THE DASHBOARD SHALL BE DEVELOPED AND MAINTAINED USING 19 **(F)** 20FUNDS FROM THE OPIOID RESTITUTION FUND AS APPROPRIATED THROUGH THE 21STATE BUDGET. 22SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23October 1, 2025.
