BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 1 2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 Article - Economic Development 10-454.4 In this part the following words have the meanings indicated. 5 (a) 6 "Commercialization" means the process of introducing a new product or (b) 7 technology into the market. 8 "Initiative" means the Maryland Innovation Initiative established under § 10-455 of this subtitle. 9 10 10 - 455.11 (a) There is a Maryland Innovation Initiative. 1210-457.There is a Maryland Innovation Initiative Fund. 13 (a) 14 (b) The purpose of the Fund is to provide funding for the purposes described in [§ 10–456] **§§ 10–456** AND **10–461** of this subtitle. 15 The Fund consists of: 16 (d) 17 (1) appropriations as provided in the State budget; 18 (2)contributions by the qualifying universities under § 10-455 of this subtitle AND ELIGIBLE UNIVERSITIES UNDER § 10–461 OF THIS SUBTITLE; 19 20 (3)grants or funds from federal laboratories located in Maryland; 21(4) interest or other income earned on the investment of money in the 22Fund: and 23(5)any other money accepted for the benefit of the Initiative. 10-461. 2425(A) **(1)** IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS

- 1 (2) "ELIGIBLE UNIVERSITY" MEANS BOWIE STATE UNIVERSITY AND 2 FROSTBURG STATE UNIVERSITY.
- 3 (3) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE MARYLAND INNOVATION INITIATIVE UNIVERSITY PARTNERSHIP EXTENSION PROGRAM.
- 5 (B) (1) THERE IS A MARYLAND INNOVATION INITIATIVE UNIVERSITY 6 PARTNERSHIP EXTENSION PROGRAM.
- 7 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO EXPAND OPPORTUNITIES
- 8 FOR TECHNOLOGY VALIDATION, ENTREPRENEURIAL DEVELOPMENT, AND
- 9 INDUSTRY ENGAGEMENT AT ELIGIBLE UNIVERSITIES.
- 10 (C) (1) THE INITIATIVE SHALL IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER THE 11 PROGRAM.
- 12 (2) THE INITIATIVE SHALL COLLABORATE WITH AN ELIGIBLE
- 13 UNIVERSITY TO IDENTIFY AND SUPPORT INDUSTRY PARTNERSHIPS AND
- 14 COMMERCIALIZATION OPPORTUNITIES.
- 15 (D) TO QUALIFY FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM, EACH ELIGIBLE 16 UNIVERSITY SHALL PAY AN ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION OF \$50,000.
- 17 (E) (1) ONLY AN ELIGIBLE UNIVERSITY MAY SUBMIT PROJECT 18 PROPOSALS FOR FUNDING UNDER THE PROGRAM.
- 19 **(2)** TO QUALIFY FOR A GRANT UNDER THE PROGRAM, A PROJECT 20 PROPOSAL MUST:
- 21 (I) SUPPORT THE CREATION OF A NEW TECHNOLOGY-BASED

- 25 (III) FOSTER ENTREPRENEURIAL DEVELOPMENT AT THE
- 26 ELIGIBLE UNIVERSITY;
- 27 (IV) CREATE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR MEANINGFUL ECONOMIC
- 28 IMPACT IN THE REGION AROUND THE ELIGIBLE UNIVERSITY; OR
- 29 (V) FOSTER COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE ELIGIBLE
- 30 UNIVERSITY AND AN INDUSTRY PARTNER, INCLUDING:

- 5 (F) (1) THE INITIATIVE SHALL DEVELOP CRITERIA TO REVIEW, 6 EVALUATE, AND RATE PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR FUNDING UNDER THE PROGRAM.
- 7 (2) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL DISTRIBUTE GRANTS TO 8 PROJECTS BASED ON THE CRITERIA DEVELOPED IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 9 (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 10 (G) (1) FOR FISCAL YEARS 2027 AND 2028, THE GOVERNOR SHALL 11 INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$500,000 FOR THE 12 PROGRAM.
- 13 (2) THE FUNDING PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE USED TO
 14 SUPPLEMENT, NOT SUPPLANT, ANY FUNDS THAT WOULD OTHERWISE BE PROVIDED
 15 TO THE INITIATIVE.
- (H) IN ADDITION TO INFORMATION ON THE INITIATIVE INCLUDED IN THE
 ANNUAL REPORT OF THE CORPORATION UNDER § 10–415 OF THIS SUBTITLE, ON OR
 BEFORE JULY 1, 2028, THE CORPORATION SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL
 ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE,
 ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAM.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2025. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2028, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
