15	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
16	INDICATED.
17	(2) "ABUSE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 4-501 OF THE FAMILY

19	(3) "DOMESTICALLY RELATED CRIME" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN

- 1 (4) "LETHALITY ASSESSMENT PROTOCOL" MEANS A MULTIPRONG 2 VALIDATED TOOL THAT:
- 3 (I) IS INTENDED TO BE USED BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER
  4 DURING THE INVESTIGATION OF A DOMESTICALLY RELATED CRIME;
- 5 (II) USES EVIDENCE-BASED QUESTIONS TO ASSESS AN 6 INDIVIDUAL'S RISK OF BEING INJURED OR KILLED BY THE INDIVIDUAL'S INTIMATE 7 PARTNER; AND
- 8 (III) INCLUDES OFFERING LOCAL RESOURCES TO INDIVIDUALS
  9 WHO ARE LIKELY TO BE INJURED OR KILLED BY AN INTIMATE PARTNER.
- 10 **(B)** EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL ADOPT A POLICY REQUIRING
  11 THE USE OF A LETHALITY ASSESSMENT PROTOCOL TO EVALUATE ANY PERSON
  12 BELIEVED TO BE A VICTIM OF OR INJURED IN RELATION TO A DOMESTICALLY
  13 RELATED CRIME OR ABUSE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
