16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Human Services**

2 (b) "Department" means the Department of Juvenile Services.

4 **ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2025, AND EACH OCTOBER 1 THEREAFTER, THE**
5 **DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT TO THE SENATE JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS**
6 **COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH §**
7 **2-1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON:**

8 **(1) EFFORTS BY THE DEPARTMENT TO PROMOTE PREDELINQUENT**
9 **PROGRAMS, INCLUDING YOUTH SERVICE BUREAUS;**

10 **(2) EFFORTS BY THE DEPARTMENT TO COLLABORATE WITH AND**
11 **PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS REGARDING THE**
12 **ESTABLISHMENT, USE, AND FUNDING OF YOUTH SERVICE BUREAUS;**

13 **(3) AN ASSESSMENT OF THE PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED**
14 **BY YOUTH SERVICE BUREAUS; AND**

15 **(4) ANY OTHER EFFORTS TO PREVENT YOUTH OFFENSES.**

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
17 1, 2025.
