- 1 (B) EACH CONTRACTOR WHO IS CONTRACTED UNDER A PUBLIC WORK 2 CONTRACT SHALL PROVIDE THE COMMISSIONER WITH THE INFORMATION LISTED 3 UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION ONCE A WEEK.
- 4 (C) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL:
- 5 (1) UPDATE THE DATA DASHBOARD DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION 6 (A) OF THIS SECTION AT LEAST ONCE A MONTH;
- 7 (2) POST THE MOST RECENTLY UPDATED DATA DASHBOARD 8 PROMINENTLY ON THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF LABOR WEBSITE; AND
- 9 (3) MAINTAIN A CACHE CONTAINING THE INFORMATION POSTED ON 10 THE DATA DASHBOARD FOR AT LEAST THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING 24 MONTHS.
- 11 **(D)** THE COMMISSIONER MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 12 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
