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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Hunter Safety Education – Issuance of Identification Number**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to issue a permanent  
4 identification number in a certain manner to each person who successfully completes  
5 a course of instruction in conservation and in competency and safety in the handling  
6 of firearms; and generally relating to hunter safety education.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Natural Resources**

20 10–301.1.

21 (a) (1) (i) On or after July 1, 1977, a person under 18 years of age may not  
22 procure a hunting license or hunt in the State, unless the person has first been issued a  
23 certificate of competency in firearms and hunter safety.

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EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (ii) On or after July 1, 1977, a person, regardless of age, may not  
2 procure a hunting license without producing a certificate of competency or a hunting license  
3 issued before July 1, 1977, or making out an affidavit that the person hunted before July  
4 1, 1977.

5 (2) (i) This section does not apply to nonresidents of Maryland who  
6 purchase a nonresident 3-day hunting license in the State to hunt wild waterfowl.

7 (ii) This section applies to nonresidents of Maryland who purchase  
8 hunting licenses in the State to hunt wildlife other than wild waterfowl.

9 (b) (1) The Department shall prescribe a course of instruction in conservation  
10 and in competency and safety in the handling of firearms.

11 (2) (i) The Department shall designate those persons or agencies  
12 authorized to give the course of instruction, and this designation shall be valid until  
13 revoked by the Department.

14 (ii) Those designated persons shall submit to the Department  
15 validated listings naming all persons who have successfully completed the course of  
16 instruction.

17 (3) (I) The Department shall issue [a certificate of competency and  
18 safety] to each person who successfully completes the course of instruction[, and the  
19 certificate]:

20 1. A CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY AND SAFETY; AND

21 2. A PERMANENT IDENTIFICATION NUMBER.

22 (II) A CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY AND SAFETY ISSUED  
23 UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH shall be valid until revoked by the Department.

24 (III) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PRINT THE PERMANENT  
25 IDENTIFICATION NUMBER ASSIGNED TO A PERSON UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH ON:

26 1. THE CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY AND SAFETY  
27 ISSUED TO THE PERSON; OR

28 2. A SEPARATE FORM PROVIDED WITH THE  
29 CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY AND SAFETY.

30 (4) The Department may not issue a certificate of competency and safety to  
31 an individual under the age of 18 unless the individual has completed satisfactorily the

1 course of instruction, or produces a certificate of competency or a hunting license issued  
2 prior to July 1, 1978, or makes out an affidavit that the individual had such a license.

3 (d) The Department shall adopt regulations to provide for the course of  
4 instruction and the issuance of the certificates consistent with the purpose of this section.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
6 October 1, 2025.
